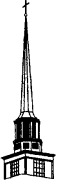

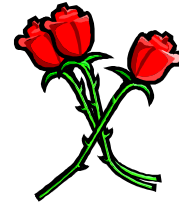

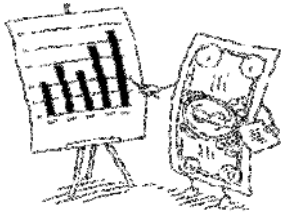

## **STEWARDSHIP CORNER**

The birth of Jesus was announced by the angels to shepherds who were watching their sheep near Bethlehem. They didn't take the news lightly. As soon as the angels had left, they went to Bethlehem. They checked out the situation. They didn't know they were stewards of the Gospel, but, the Bible tells us, "When they had seen Him, they spread the word concerning what had been told them about this child, and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them" (Luke 2:17-18). Let's join the shepherds and "spread the word concerning what [has] been told [us] about this child..."



We hear, "Tis the season to be jolly," but jolly is not what many feel. We are at war, there are economic concerns, and our list of things still to be done is lengthy. Season to be jolly? Hmm. Where did we ever get the idea that Christmas is supposed to be all laughter and merriment. That first Christmas was filled with problems. Taxes, for instance. Joseph had to go pay taxes. There were housing problems. The only motel had a No Vacancy sign. Herod was a tyrannical monarch who took advantage of the people. There were travel problems, too. The wise men had no road map. Even the shepherds had problems. Danger marked each day, for wolves eat sheep and bandits were not above snatching a fat one to make up a stew. The wool market may have fluctuated some-

what. Some years there were not enough twins at lambing time to make a reasonable profit. It's a wonder the poor, distracted shepherds even heard the angels' song.

And yet, there is something about Christmas that transcends all we are dealing with. It isn't jollity, but joy. Worried shepherds felt it when they heard and when they saw. Troubled Joseph felt it as he watched Jesus being born and remembering what the angel had said. Wise men felt it as they knelt and worshiped the Child. Tis the season to be jolly? Well, now and then...for there is laughter and enjoyment to be shared. But this is especially the season to be joyful, to be filled with that deep and pervasive joy that puts troubles in a new perspective and gives rise to Mary's song, "My soul doth magnify the Lord!" In the midst of all the concerns this Advent, may we find true joy within and that will enable us to deal with everything else. Join us in worship.

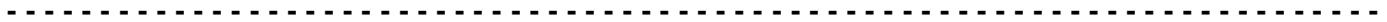

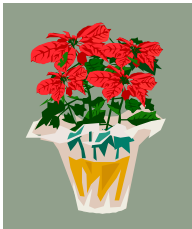
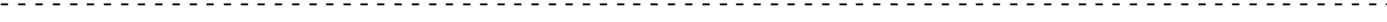
