As we come to Christmas, I want you to clearly understand two things and never forget them – a diagnosis and a prognosis of our lives. The diagnosis - listen. Hear this in your heart and hear it well: we have plenty of everything, except what we need to make what we have worthwhile. That's the diagnosis. Now the prognosis. Christmas is possible when we realize that the best we have without Christ is not enough for salvation, not enough to give us abundant life. We need a Messiah, a Savior. That's actually one of life's hardest things, to acknowledge our need for Christ. In all of our getting and spending, our humdrum and routine, our accumulation of things, our continuous going and coming to relieve the boredom of staying where we are, the

way we excuse our selfishness, our efforts to justify ourselves, the continuous energy we spend to prove ourselves, the way we go about trying to rationalize our un-involvement with the needs of the world, the way we seek salvation in so many places...we seem to be ever failing to realize our need for Christ. Sure, we can make do and get along ok, but God doesn't want us to have an "ok" life, He wants us to have abundant life. When Christ has been born into our lives, He is born into all of life. Maybe we don't have a sense of our need for Christ in many parts of our lives. We have plenty except what we need, and what we need is to realize that we cannot find what we are looking for in ourselves. Christmas tells us that God has reached out to us through His Son and as we realize our need for Him, He comes to give us new life, abundant life. This Christmas, consider your need for Christ to be a ever greater part of your life.

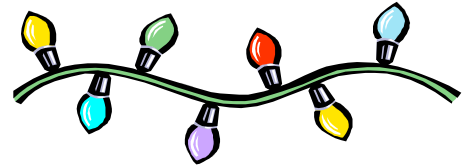

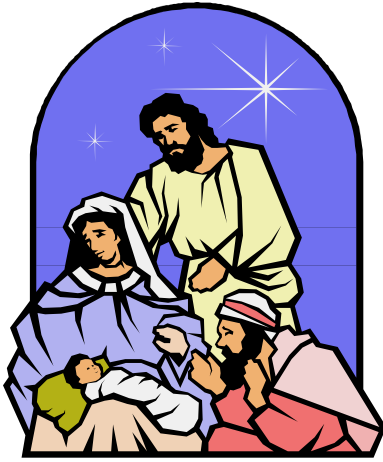
