STEWARDSHIP CORNER

Why do we decorate our Christmas trees with lights? Of course, we enjoy the beauty of those lights, especially in a darkened room, but take some time this Christmas season to meditate in that quiet dark room where your tree stands all aglow. Think about what those lights represent: the Son of God, in whom "... was life, and that life was the light of men." (John 1:4) Then "... testify concerning that light, so that through Him all men might believe." (John 1:7)



At Bethlehem that first Christmas night there was one group that knew all about this holy Child. The shepherds were wondering. Mary was learning. But the angels from the realms of glory knew the meaning and purpose of that holy night.

And so angels sang! They had no anxious fears or lingering doubts. They knew that after the long years of waiting, God's plan was working out, as it always does. They knew that the Child, now begotten in a manger and soon to die on a Cross, had come to offer humanity forgiveness of sins and peace with God.

And so they sang! They sang before the smallest audience in their history, but they knew, too, that behind the shepherds huddled by their fire, past the Judean hills and into a larger world, there was a great crowd of men and women, beyond measure and numbering, who would over time find in the Child a new song and an everlasting hope.

And so they sang! They are still singing. Our task and our joy today is to hear them sing again, above the noise and darkness of our time, above sin and shame. The stars of Christmas shine as soon as it is dark enough, and the angels sing as soon as we are quiet enough. And when we have become still with the peace of God, we can join them in their song. Be sure this Christmas to find a place of quiet and listen to the song of the angels. We need to be good listeners this season. Hope to see you in church.

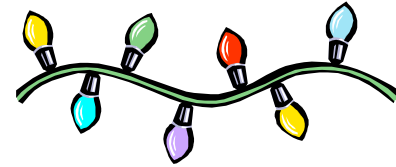

LEWISVILLE IS A STEPHEN MINISTRY CHURCH

Stephen Ministers are trained lay care-givers who provide emotional and spiritual care to persons who are experiencing difficulties in their lives—hospitalization, loss of a loved one, loss of job, or any other crisis situation. This is care in addition to the care the pastor gives. If you are interested in having a Stephen Minister, fill out one of the slips in the pew rack and put it in the offering plate or hand it to the minister or one of the Stephen Leaders, Becky Bingham or Tom Lee.

LEWISVILLE UMC BUILDING FUND REPORT

At the beginning of 2008, our Building Fund Loan Balance was \$425,000. Over this year we have been able to pay down that loan balance by \$80,000, leaving a current loan of \$345,000. We paid interest charges on the average of \$1,583 per month. Our interest rate is less than the prime rate and is variable. We have two years left on the loan note. If we make the same annual contribution for the next two years, we will be \$185,000 short of paying off the construction loan when the note is due. **Our need is to pay as much on the principal as is possible each month.** The more we chisel away at the principal, the lower the interest payment becomes, and therefore there is more we can put toward the principal.

As an example, the interest in January 2008 was \$2,495, but in December, was down to \$950. This is largely attributable to the fact that giving to the Building Fund increased by 36% over last year.

As the year ends, consider a special Christmas gift to the Lewisville UMC Building Fund and help us reduce the principal. Thanks to all those who have faithfully contributed to the Building Fund this year. We have enjoyed the new building and it has enhanced our church and provided us new opportunities for ministry.
