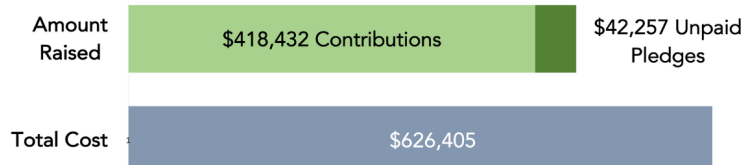

SANCTUARY RENOVATION UPDATE

On July 12th, Lewisville UMC's Church Conference approved a sanctuary renovation by Church Interiors, with construction scheduled to begin after Christmas. In addition to the \$300,000 the church had in hand for the project, the congregation has raised \$160,689 in contributions and pledges. This includes a matching gift of \$50,000 from an anonymous donor and represents 3/4 of the total estimated cost for the renovation.

In September, the Building Committee approved a contract that includes an updated floorpan, a new location for the sound booth, matching light fixtures in the narthex, an enhanced assisted listening system, and updates to the choir and organ areas. These additions, along with the rising cost of labor, have increased the total estimated cost by \$22,751. Once construction begins, the project will take four months to complete.
