

Disaster Ministries: Hurricane Helene Western North Carolina Conference The United Methodist Church

HELENE RECOVERY MISSION TEAMS AUGUST 17-22; OCTOBER 5-11

Since Hurricane Helene struck last fall, our church has donated over \$17,500, delivered 4 truck loads of supplies and 338 flood buckets, and trained 15 individuals as Early Response Team (ERT) volunteers. Now, Jim Eckelkamp and Pastor Paul will be leading two long-term recovery mission teams in Spruce Pine this August and October. Volunteers must be at least 14 years old and will engage in construction projects such as flooring, roofing, and painting while also serving as a caring Christian presence, fostering relationships and showing the light of Christ through the ministry of presence.
