### Care

- The next Red Cross Blood Drive will be at New Hope AME Zion Church on Saturday, July 11th, from 9am-1:30pm.
- Disaster response to the earthquake in Venezuela: We will be collecting needed items and transporting them to Hillsdale United Methodist Church for transport. You can bring these items to the Care Corner in the Narthex. Needed items are: Personal hygiene products (example: toothpaste, soap, deodorant), canned or pouched protein foods (example: canned or pouched chicken, tuna, sardines), infant baby formula, and dried beans.
- LCAP Needs: chicken broth, beef broth, toothbrushes, tea bags. At our May distribution event, 52 adults and 19 children were blessed with much needed food and household supplies.
- There will be an informational meeting about Zoe Empowers on Sunday, July 26th, at 10am in the Sanctuary, led by Tim and Suzanne Howard. Our youth leader, Amanda Batten, mentioned this ministry in her sermon and it is supported by the United Methodist Church. Zoe Empowers is a global non-profit organization that provides vulnerable children and orphans with tools, training, and a support-network to become self-reliant within three years.
- On Saturday, August 15th, we will be hosting a Rise Against Hunger meal packing event in our Fellowship Hall. Together with six other United Methodist churches in the West Forsyth Missional Network, we will be packing 15,000 meals that will be shipped around the world.
