



We are excited to announce that the LUMC Trustees approved upgrading the entry points into the church with an enhanced Access Control system. This system will provide structured access into the building as opposed to the generic codes currently being used. Planning for system access is underway. Once started, we expect it to take 3-4 weeks for installation. During that time period, we will be collecting additional data and creating the necessary access codes. Please be patient as this process will take a little time to develop. The end result should be a more secure church for everyone.
