#### 2024 LUMCP Summer Camp Information & Policies

Thanks for enrolling into our Summer Camp program. Whether your child is attending one week or all of them, they are sure to have a fun filled summer!

Each week we follow a different theme. We will have themed crafts and activities each day. Class lists will be posted on the bulletin board each week. Last minute changes may be made if needed. Children may be with different teachers or be in a different classroom each week. Keep an eye out for announcements for special activities that may require swimsuits and/or towels.

All children need to bring a bag with a change of clothes (and shoes if possible) daily. They may also bring a water bottle/sippy cup. If your child is not potty trained, make sure to provide diapers/pull-ups in their bags as well. All items should be clearly marked with the child's name.

Please apply sunscreen before arriving to camp. It will not be applied/reapplied during camp hours.

If you have questions, your child will be absent, or you need immediate assistance during camps, please call/text Starr Green 336-631-0873

#### **Drop off Policy:**

The camp day is from 8:55 am until 11:55 am. The doors to the lobby will open at 8:55 am, to start signing in. Children must be signed in at the welcome center before going to class. Adults will walk with their child down the hallway to their classroom door. Children are dropped off at the classroom door. If you need to speak with a teacher regarding an extensive matter, please let them know and they may speak with you at the end of the day when all children have left the room or make an appointment with them for a later time. Each child must wash their hands upon entering their classroom.

#### **Pick Up Policy:**

Children should be picked up from the preschool at 11:55 am and no later than 12:10pm. When children are not picked up by 12:10pm, a late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged and added to your bill. Because we realize that traffic tie-ups, mechanical problems with cars, and family emergencies can cause unforeseen problems in getting to camp on any given day, please call Starr Green (336-631-0873) if these issues come up.

#### Illness:

No child should come to the camp visibly ill. If a child has had a fever, diarrhea or vomiting 24 hours before the start of camp, the child should not return until 24 hours after the last incident. Apply the "Golden Rule" when in doubt. Do not bring your child with symptoms you would not want your family exposed to.

If your child has diarrhea, vomiting and/or a fever of 100.4 degrees or above during the camp hours, parents will be called for pick up and child must not return for 24 hours after the last incident.

If a child becomes ill or is injured at camp, we will try to contact you. If we cannot contact you, the child will be isolated and cared for until you come at the regular pick-up time. If there is an emergency situation, we will contact who you have provided on the Emergency Information section of the enrollment form, if necessary, we will utilize the emergency medical release you signed. Please notify us when your child has a contagious condition or disease. We can then notify parents of other children who have been exposed. We will make every effort to observe good health practices at school by assisting children with hand washing, providing nutritious snacks, and including outdoor playtime each day.

#### 2024 LUMCP Summer Camp Information & Policies Continued

#### **Clothing and Possessions:**

Mark any removable clothing (sweaters, coats, hats, etc.), books, toys, or other items with your child's name. Please do not allow your child to bring "special" items to the camp, which could be easily damaged while at the preschool. Dress your child in clothing that is durable and comfortable. Clothing should also be manageable by children who are capable of using the bathroom alone. Choose fabrics that are easily laundered if stained by art materials or snack foods.

#### Snacks:

Mid-morning snacks are provided for all children. We try to encourage healthy eating by the nutritious foods we offer. Please do not send any food, gum, candy, or drinks unless the teacher has agreed. Water is provided with the daily snack. Snack foods are served in small portions and do not serve as a substitute for breakfast. Be sure your child has a filling, nutritious breakfast before coming to camp.

#### Reimbursements:

Tuition will be refunded up until one week before the camp starts. For example, Week 1 (June 10th-14th) will not be refunded after noon on Monday June 3rd. The registration fee is non-refundable.

#### **Payment Information:**
