LUMC SANCTUARY RENOVATION

Years ago, one of our devoted members, Mr. G. Galloway "Buck" Reynolds, designated a portion of his estate to our church for future building improvements. That money became available to the church last year in the sum of approximately \$215,000. The Trustees are currently working on a proposal to use these funds to help cover the cost of a sanctuary renovation. Once the Trustees complete their work, they will share their proposal with the Finance Team and then with the congregation at a special information session. A final decision on any significant building renovation requires approval by the Church Council / Charge Conference. Dates for the information session and Charge Conference will be communicated to the congregation ahead of time via newsletter, email, the church website, and Sunday morning announcements.

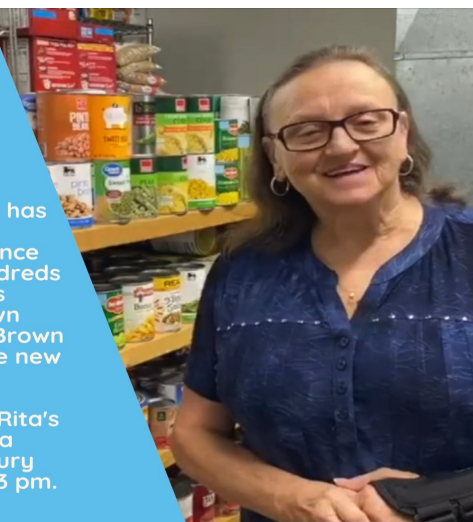
