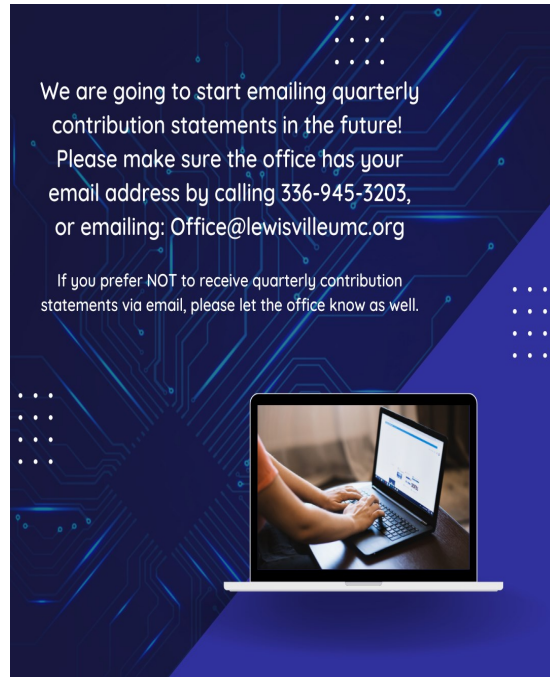

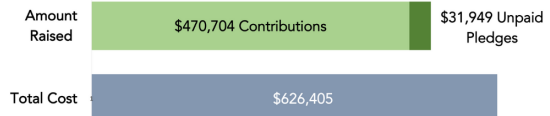

LEWISVILLE UMC IS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

Lewisville UMC's final worship service in the current sanctuary will be New Year's Day, with work scheduled to begin on our sanctuary renovation project the next day and take approximately four months to complete.

In addition to the \$300,000 the church had in hand for the project, the congregation has raised more than \$200,000 in contributions and pledges, representing 80% of the total estimated cost of the renovation.

Throughout the duration of the project, both the 9 am contemporary service and the 11 am traditional service will be held in the Fellowship Hall. Updates will be provided via the midweek emails and on our website.
