

Lewisville UMC 2023 Confirmation Expectations

In order to be Confirmed on May 21st, confirmands are expected to meet all of the following expectations. Confirmation is a serious commitment, which results in becoming a full member of Lewisville United Methodist Church. It is important to make attendance and participation a priority.

1.) Weekly Reflection Assignments: Each week, confirmands will be given a weekly reflection assignment to complete and turn in at the next class. This may be a reflection on a Scripture passage, or about something we learned about. This reflection should take no more than 15 minutes to complete. Confirmands are expected to complete the reflection assignment each week. If a confirmand is absent, the reflection assignment will be provided to them via email.

2.) Class Attendance: Ideally, confirmands would attend all Confirmation classes. However, we understand that sometimes absences are unavoidable. If a confirmand misses more than 2 classes, they will need to make up the missed classes in a way agreed upon by Pastor Kara, the confirmand, and the confirmand's parent/guardians.

3.) Worship Attendance: Confirmands are expected to attend worship regularly. Confirmands are required to attend worship 6 times during the Confirmation process (Feb 19th-May 21st).

4.) Youth Group Attendance: Confirmands are expected to regularly participate in the ministries of Lewisville UMC. Confirmands are required to attend Lewisville Youth Group at least one time during the Confirmation process (Feb 19th-May 21st). Lewisville Youth Group meets most Sundays from 4:30-6:00 pm. A Youth Ministry schedule is included in the Confirmation Info packet.

5.) Participate in the Confirmation Service: Confirmands will be confirmed at the 11:00 am Traditional Worship Service on Sunday, May 21st. Attendance at this service is required in order to be confirmed.

6.) Attend the Confirmation Kick-Off Meeting with at least one parent or guardian. At this meeting, all important information about confirmation will be shared and explained, including a Confirmation covenant to be signed by confirmands and their parent or guardian.
