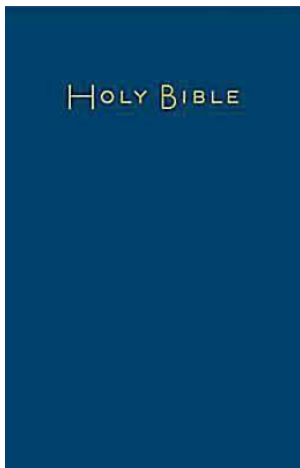

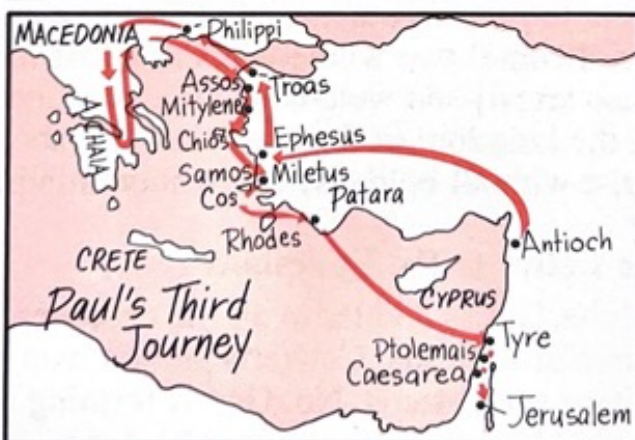
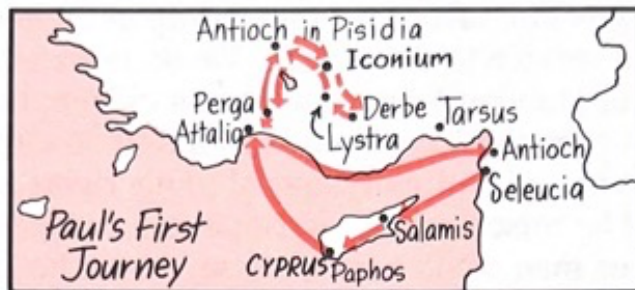

SUGGESTIONS FOR GROUP MEMBERS

1. Expect God to teach you through the scriptures being discussed and through the other members in the group.
2. Be willing to participate in the discussion.
3. Be sensitive and listen to other members of the group. Many questions do not have “right” answers. Instead, questions push us to explore the Bible more deeply.
4. Be careful not to dominate the discussion. By all means participate! But allow others to also. We will provide time for each person present to talk if he or she feels comfortable doing so.
5. Anything said in the group is considered confidential and will not be discussed outside the group unless permission is given to do so.
6. We will talk about ourselves and our own situations, avoiding conversations about other people.
7. We will be very cautious about giving advice.

- 36–46 Paul in Tarsus; brought to Antioch by Barnabas
- 40 Gaius (Caligula) plans to erect statue in Jerusalem
