FACILITY UPDATE

One year ago, our congregation began worshiping in the Fellowship Hall as the sanctuary renovation project began. Now, not only are we worshiping in our newly renovated sanctuary, but thanks to the generosity of God's people and several large year-end gifts, the balance on the renovation loan has been reduced to less than \$35,000. Once the church receives a sales tax refund for the renovation costs, we will nearly be able to pay off the loan!

In the fall, the church identified a need to replace the roof over the Sunday School classes and Fellowship Hall. Some anonymous donors stepped up and covered the entire cost of replacing the roof - a project that's now underway!

God is truly good all the time and we are blessed to be part of a church family that practices extravagant generosity in order to advance our mission in 2024 and beyond. We appreciate everyone who made financial commitments to help us pay off the sanctuary loan as soon as possible. Once the loan is paid off, any additional contributions toward the renovation will go to the church's capital improvement fund.

LCAP recieves grant to expand services

In December, the leadership of the Lewisville Community Assistance Program recieved word that LCAP was selected to receive a \$12,000 grant from the Yadkin Valley District Vitality Team of The United Methodist Church. This grant will allow LCAP to respond to the growing need in our community for rent and utility assistance. The grant will also allow LCAP to distribute more fresh meat and dairy products at the bi-monthly food distribution events. Lastly, this grant will support the continued mission of our community garden, which supports the LCAP food pantry during the warmer months. Congratulations to LCAP and program director, Melony Brown for securing these funds that will help LCAP continue to make the town of Lewisville a little bit more like the Kingdom of God.

Refugee Ministry

On Thursday, December 21st, our church's Good Neighbor Team hosted the M'Boko family for a Christmas party followed by a trip in the church bus to the Tanglewood Lights. Our Christmas gift to the family was a new freezer. On Christmas Eve, we collected \$2,042 - all of which will go toward the refugee ministry of our Good Neighbor Team and World Relief Triad.
