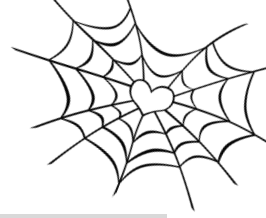


A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAUL

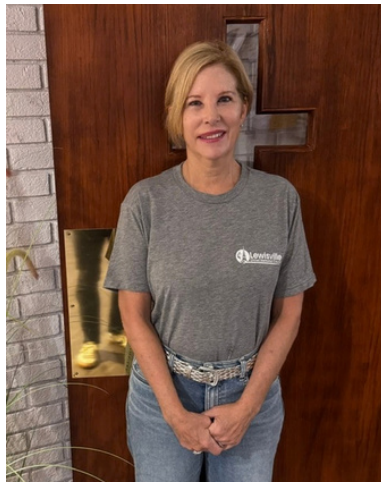

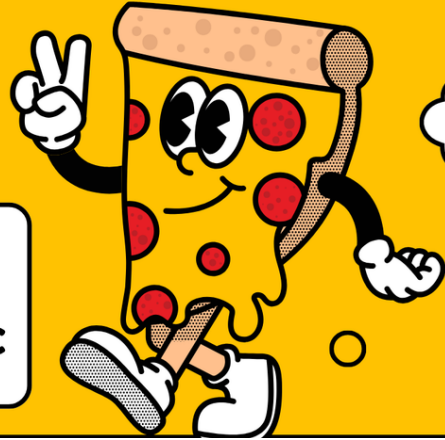

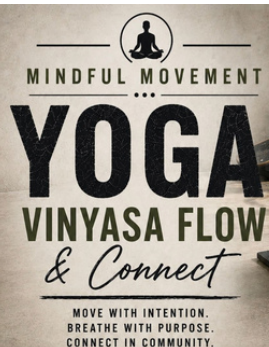
